Effective 3/31/2011 the Town of Hebron left the H-B Refuse district. As of 4/01/2011 the H-B Refuse District will serve only the Town of Bridgewater along with a limited number of individual paying customers.

New 2011 stickers will be required to use the facility. These stickers may be obtained at the Refuse facility, at the Bridgewater Town office, or by sending a self-addressed stamped envelope with your request to the Town office at 297 Mayhew Tpke, Bridgewater, NH 03222. There is no charge for the stickers; however, proof of ownership or residency in Bridgewater will generally be required to obtain a sticker. *(This could be a listing on the Town's 911 address list, a copy of a tax bill, a utility bill, or a driver's license showing your name and the Bridgewater address.)* Normally a maximum of two stickers per household will be issued. If there is a special need for more, the Commissioners may authorize additional stickers. These stickers must be placed permanently inside a driver's side window of your vehicle, so that the attendants can easily see the sticker.

In the case of rental units, there is a new procedure/requirement!!

A temporary sticker valid only for specific dates will be issued by the Town office upon application by the property owner. These stickers may be obtained at the Town office, or by sending a request indicating the Bridgewater rental property address, the owner's name, the dates required, and a self-addressed stamped envelope to the Town office. The white sticker will be valid ONLY for the dates indicated on the sticker and must be placed on the outside of a driver's side window of the vehicle used. Renters should be given a copy of the H-B Refuse District 2011 regulations, along with the white sticker marked with the valid dates. Please allow 2 weeks to process requests for temporary stickers by mail.
